Gifts to our Community: *Artisphere* Public Art Installations, 2005-2015



Artisphere is proud to have commissioned and installed original works of art that have celebrated both the Festival and the community that supports it by adding to the beauty of our streetscapes.



The first Artisphere Festival in 2005 was marked by the installation of this original work entitled *Nexus of Light* by sculptor Dennis Heimbach.

For the 10th Anniversary festival in 2014, the Artisphere Board of Directors commissioned local artist John Acorn to create *Ten Artispheres*. The piece anchors the southwest corner of the Main Street bridge and contrasts Acorn's smoother *Orbital Trio* at NOMA Square.



In 2012, with support from the Daniel-Mickel Foundation, Artisphere installed this work entitled *Paradign Pathway* by South Carolina artist Stephen Kishel on the Reedy River footbridge. The work is dedicated to the memory of one of Greenville's great arts lovers and patrons, the late Buck A. Mickel.
